SPOT 1 | Statue of Elvis Presley

This new high site for the king is visited by a great number of Elvis fans. Carrying 1 of the only 3 remaining Elvis statues in the world as of 2009, our town is awaiting your arrival.




SPOT 3 | Harbor walk

This wooden pedestrian path runs along the sea from the side of the redbrick warehouses to the former Kobe port signal station. Equipped with gas lanterns and benches, breath in the ocean air on this walking path.

Transportation information for travelling in town

CITY LOOP

This bus service runs through 18 major tourist spots in the downtown area in one loop of about 65 minutes.



Port Loop

This is a bus service with an articulated bus running between Shin-Kobe and the waterfront area.



The tickets give free rides on loop buses, including Port Loop and CITY LOOP. They are recommended to those wishing to tour the sightseeing spots in the city of Kobe.



Kobelin

This is a system for renting bicycles, where you can return a bike at any of the multiple cycle ports located in the center of Kobe City.

These two seaside redbrick warehouses exude the atmosphere of a foreign country. Built in the latter half of the 1890's, they were used as warehouses for freight arriving in the port of Kobe. Today, they house stylish restaurants and popular shops.



SPOT 4 | MOSAIC Big Ferris Wheel

This illuminated Ferris wheel is fitted with 120,000 LED lights. Take in the 360 degree panoramic view, while enjoying the nighttime port atmosphere and town scenery at this recommended spot.



SPOT 5 | Kobe Anpanman Children's Museum & Mall

The hands-on museum and the shopping mall let you see and enjoy the world of Anpanman, an animated television hero loved by children for many years.

SPOT 6 | THE KOBE DINING CRUISE Cruising Restaurant CONCERTO

Offering relaxing cruises, meals, scenery, performances and other events. Enjoy the cordial services along with a view that changes each hour with the concertos!



SPOT 7 | Gaslight Street

Gaslight Street and Harbor Road are lined with 100 zelkova trees lit up with bright white LED bulbs. Enjoy the harmony of the soft gaslight and bright LED light.



SPOT 8 | Kobe Harborland Onsen (hot springs) Manyo Club

This urban hot spring uses a simple alkaline water for its baths. From the rooftop observation garden, you can take in a view of the Kobe port while enjoying a relaxing foot bath. This facility also offers a hot stone sauna, restaurants, various wellness services and movies.
